This is where the dream comes real and takes away the viewer's breath; just like the ancient Iranian myths, where there are no boundaries between dream and real; the myths we have been accustomed to from childhood. We have lived with these myths and my fathers and forebears have left their legacy of joys and sorrows to us through these myths and whispered them to every beat of our heart; the myths reflective like a mirror, where you see all you want.

Sometimes looking inwards, and sometimes looking outwards; which concept has been the designer's concern?

The designer ascends motives derived from Iranian carpet from earth to the heaven and places them on the ceiling, wishing to exalt the Iranian culture one more time.

The silk curtains like blue dreams separate one space from the other, images of Iranian myths appear on the glass partitions, and black mirrors reflect thousands of images in every corner, as a hint to meaning of the Iranian myths.

A combination of sharp colors and Iranian motives makes the furniture a new appearance of the ancient Iranian legends.

The restaurant is separated from the adjacent corridor by wooden axial partitions on a side of which Attar's poems narrate "The Seven Valleys of Love"; the seven Valleys passing through which the corporal Man ascends to heavenly presence of the Divine:

- *The Valley of Quest*
- *The Valley of Love*
- *The Valley of Understanding*
- *The Valley of Independence and Detachment*
- *The Valley of Unity*
- *The Valley of Astonishment and Bewilderment*
- *The Valley of Deprivation and Death*
